### Tier 2 Weight Management Program for adults

Rainham Leisure Centre will be hosting a free, inclusive, educating, and motivating lifestyle changing program. Participants are to commit to attending a weekly 2 hour session consisting of a 1 hour class room based session and a 45 minute low impact physical activity group session for 12 weeks. It is aimed at Havering residents aged 18 or over with a BMI of 25 - 44.9, self-referral or referral by health or non-health professional. Participants receive ongoing support and follow ups for up to a year after commencing the programme. One course will run in the afternoon and one in the evening so if getting fitter is one of your goals for 2024 why not start here.
